Stunning nature reserve

A narrow archipelago of more than 1,780 islands and islets, Palawan is the undisputed final frontier in the Philippines. There's plenty to do in this extraordinary island but the main activity is simply admiring nature's handiwork.

Palawan's bewitching landscapes include storied lagoons, bays hiding ancient shipwrecks, uncharted mountains, mangrove swamps, hidden pockets of lush forest, deserted islets ringed by coral reefs, kaleidoscopic sea gardens, isolated white sand beaches, and majestic limestone cliffs.

Calauit Game Preserve & Wildlife Sanctuary

A protected national park and refuge for exotic African animals, as well as endangered native fauna.

Coron Island

Seven enchanting lakes surrounded by craggy limestone cliffs attract nature lovers to this island in northern Palawan.

Cuyo Fort

Built during the 1600s, it is one of the oldest and most unique forts in the Philippines. Within its walls are a church and a convent.

El Nido Marine Reserve

Now one of the country's premier tourist destinations, El Nido's diverse ecosystems include rainforest, mangroves, white sand beaches, coral reefs, and limestone cliffs. It is the sanctuary of various wildlife including the sea cow.

Honda Bay

The bay has several islets with shallow reefs bordering fabulous beaches which have become one of the favourite swimming, snorkeling, and diving destinations in Palawan.

Puerto Princesa Subterranean National Park

This World Heritage site features an 8.2 kilometre underground river, reputed to be the world's longest. It winds through a spectacular cave of stalactite pillars, rock formations, and domed amphitheatres before emptying out into the South China Sea.

Palawan is a haven for wildlife wonders where giraffes, zebras and gazelles co-exist with exotic fauna like the mouse deer, civet and scaly anteater.

Far from the beaten track, Palawan's fabulous beaches, diving sites and scenic wonders lure intrepid travellers. From the adventurous backpacker to the discriminating tourist seeking a nature adventure in plush surroundings, Palawan is an enchanting destination.

Rasa Island

Bird sanctuary where over 60 species, including the Philippine Cockatoo, take refuge.

Tabon Caves

Known as the "Cradle of Philippine Civilization", Tabon Caves consist of a series of chambers where the remains of the 22,000-year-old Tabon Man, along with Stone Age artifacts, were discovered.

Tubbataha Reefs

A World Heritage site with breathtaking coral reef and marine life.

Ursula Island Game Refuge and Bird Sanctuary

A haven for birds that converge here to rest, two hours before sunset.

holiday notes

- watch the birds' nest gatherers at work, scaling cliffs for the prized swiftlet's nest that will make its way to a Chinese restaurant in Cebu or Manila
- spectacular scuba diving sites abound in Bacuit Bay (El Nido), Coron and Port Barton
- the Napsan Cross-Country and Nagtabon Beach Cross-Country routes are a must for mountain biking enthusiasts
- bushwalking in Palawan is challenging but rewarding, luring the adventurous through formidable cliffs, rainforests teeming with wildlife, and tribal communities
- for souvenir shopping, the best buys are shell craft, woodcarvings, wild honey and woven bags
